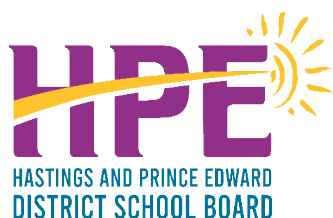
Pre-Registration Process

All students who pre-register for the French Immersion program by Friday, February 24, 2023, will be enrolled in their respective program pending adequate enrolment of 25 students, available space and qualified staff. Priority will be given to students registering within their prescribed school attendance area for elective learning programs (host school), based on their home address.

If classes are full, students will be placed on a wait list. Parents requesting consideration for attendance outside their prescribed school area must register first at their host school then complete Form 340-1: Request for Transfer.

If transportation is needed, please contact the principal of the French Immersion school.
